** Indicates fastbreaking teams. These teams run the fastbreak offense at every opportunity.

* Indicates teams that run a patterned offense. These teams use the fastbreak only about a third of all possible opportunities. All other teams fastbreak about two-thirds of all possible opportunities. All teams will perform realistically when the suggested offenses are used accordingly.

If BAL appears in the Blocked Section of the X Column, assume all missed shots to be blocked.

PLEASE NOTE:

(1) When attempting a 3-Pt. Shot, if the dice roll is listed in 3-Pt. Replay - follow normal replay rules. Otherwise, 3- Pt. shooting rules apply.

(2) On the players' cards and on the advanced defensive cards the abbreviations O, P, I, F replace outside shot, penetration shot, inside shot and rebound shot, and fastbreak shot respectively.

(3) That stars replace asterisks under shooting tendency on the players' cards.

The "Rodman Rule"

Due to the outstanding rebounding that Dennis Rodman of Detroit performed last season we are creating a specialized rule to be used whenever Rodman is in the game. This rule only applies to Rodman and only for his cards based on the 1991-92 and 1992-93 seasons. Whenever Rodman is in the game and a rebounding reading occurs that begins with the word "Any" (for example, "Any Offensive player 7 or more . . .") Rodman automatically gets the rebound REGARDLESS IF HE IS ON OFFENSE OR DEFENSE. Note that he overrides any opposing player who would otherwise qualify to receive the "Any" rebound. To reiterate, any time Rodman is in the game and a rebound reading starting with "Any" occurs it's Rodman's ball. This rule will make Rodman as valuable as he was in real life, and will allow Rodman to generate accurate rebounding statistics.

Please note that on Chicago Scottie Pippen should play right guard on offense and right forward on defense. Michael Jordan should play right forward on offense and guard on defense.

STRAT-O-MATIC RULE CHANGES

REPLACEMENT FOUL ASSIGNMENT CHART - Use the chart to the right instead of the one located on the Super-Advanced Instruction sheet. This new chart improves the statistical accuracy of the game.

REPLACEMENT RULE FOR "ADDITIONAL THREE-POINT SHOTS ALLOWED" CHART - Additional three-point shots are allowed as follows (ignore the chart on the Super-Advanced rules sheet): (1) Anytime a team trails by 10 or more points they may take unlimited three-point shots. (2) In the last 10 minutes of the game if a team is trailing by more points than time left (for example, down by 6 with 5 minutes to go), they may take unlimited three-point shots. (3) In the last two minutes of the game, both teams can take unlimited three-point shots, regardless of the score. Note that the term "unlimited" is still governed by the other rules of the game. In other words, a player must ALWAYS be positioned outside in order to take a three-point shot. Also, when using the solitaire rules to determine if a player should penetrate or shoot outside, you should place higher emphasis on these "unlimited" three-pointers - the player should be able to shoot a three-pointer without rolling to determine if he should penetrate (if the three-point shot is desirable, that is).
