To insure realism, passing cards for second string quarterbacks who threw less than 100 passes were adjusted according to their past records or reduced below the records achieved by their teams' first string quarterbacks. Also, we suggest that Joe Namath of the New York Jets play in only five games. To further insure realism, certain substitute running backs' yards per carry average were reduced by their longest runs. We suggest that you throw few or no short or long passes to potential receivers who do not have any listing (completed pass caught) for that type of pass on their receiving cards.

Below is a listing containing the number of times each team ran or passed. Included in passing attempts are the total number of times quarterbacks were tackled attempting to pass. This is a helpful guide in determining your offensive plays.
