### MISCELLANEOUS RULES

**To ensure realism, we suggest that you adhere closely to the number of passing attempts, rushing attempts and receptions for all skill players.** Please also restrict the following players to the number of games indicated: Arik Armstead – SF (9), David Bakhtiari – GB (11), Jeremy Chinn – CAR (11), Cameron Dantzer – MIN (10), Aaron Donald – LA-NFC (11), Bud Dupree – TEN (11), Kristian Fulton – TEN (11), Rashan Gary – GB (9), Nate Herbig – NY-AFC (11), Akiem Hicks – TB (11), Nate Hobbs – LV (11), Armani Hooker – TEN (9), Bruce Irvin – SEA (11), Adoree' Jackson – NY-NFC (10), Jaylon Johnson – CHI (11), Javon Kinlaw – SF (6), Marshon Lattimore – NO (7), Marcus Maye – NO (10), Trent McDuffie – KC (11), Von Miller – BUF (11), Byron Murphy – ARI (9), Billy Price – ARI (11), D.J. Green Bay and most one back offensive teams frequently use three and four receiver offenses. Please do not start players designated as substitutes. Use them only in special situations, usually pass situations.

**PISTOL RATED QUARTERBACKS** - Certain Quarterbacks are rated to play the Pistol. Pistol Quarterbacks have End Run cards that are computed differently than traditional Quarterbacks (some of the yardage from the Guessed Wrong column is shifted to the Guessed Right column). In the 2021 season the following QB's are eligible to run the Pistol – Allen (BUF), Fields (CHI), Hill (NO), Huntley, (BAL), Hurts (PHI), Jackson (BAL), Jones (NYG), Lance (SF), Mariota (ATL), Murray (ARI).

When a Pistol Quarterback is in the game the Pistol rules will be in effect anytime the manager calls for the Shotgun. Pistol Quarterbacks cannot run the Shotgun, however there would be no strategic reason to do so as the Pistol rule expands upon the Shotgun rule giving you more flexibility without taking anything away. The Pistol can be used with any formation (announce it with the formation). When it is used, it decreases all Pass Rush ratings by 1. When using the Pistol all runs are allowed except for End Runs by a Running Back. In addition, whether they are in the Pistol formation, Pistol Quarterbacks are allowed an additional 2 end runs per game above the number of End Runs normal Quarterbacks are allowed.

#### **PLAYING A "CB" OR "Defensive Back" AT LEFT CORNERBACK OR RIGHT CORNERBACK**

Players listed as "Cornerback" under Defensive Player Substitutes on their teams' Defensive Rating Card may be used as substitutes at LCB or RCB with the following adjustment: If the CB is rated as a "6" defensively then count him as a "4" defensively when playing LCB or RCB. All other CB's should be counted as a "0" defensively when playing LCB or RCB. Note that this rule also applies to those players rated as "Defensive Back" when positioned at LCB or RCB.

**IMPORTANT:** This rule only applies to the 2017 and later NFL season when Strat-O-Matic started rating CB's specifically as slot cornerbacks.

**NEW FOR 2022 SEASON:** Instead of carding players with minimal usage to fill out a team, we have decided to card players with more significant usage for 2022. Please note the following player cards will appear on a different team sheet: Eno Benjamin (New Orleans) on Dallas; David Blough (Arizona) on Carolina; Melvin Gordon (Denver) on Cincinnati; Tanner Hudson (New York NFC) on New England; Kadarius Toney (Kansas City) on Philadelphia.
